**A BILL**

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire land in Frederick County, Maryland, for the Historic Preservation Training Center of the National Park Service, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Frederick Jobs and  
5 Historic Preservation Training Center Land Acquisition  
6 Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

8 In this Act:

1           (1) CENTER.—The term “Center” means the  
2           Historic Preservation Training Center and related  
3           facilities of the National Park Service in Frederick  
4           County, Maryland.

5           (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means  
6           the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-  
7           rector of the National Park Service.

8   **SEC. 3. ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PUR-**  
9                           **POSES OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRAIN-**  
10                          **ING CENTER.**

11          (a) IN GENERAL.—To further develop the Center in  
12          accordance with section 305306 of title 54, United States  
13          Code, the Secretary may acquire not more than 20 acres  
14          of land or interests in land in Frederick County, Mary-  
15          land, for the Center for the purpose of supporting the  
16          physical space, program initiatives, and workforce develop-  
17          ment capacity of the Center.

18          (b) METHOD OF ACQUISITION.—Land or an interest  
19          in land for the Center may only be acquired under sub-  
20          section (a) by donation, transfer, exchange, or purchase  
21          from a willing seller using donated or appropriated funds.

22          (c) ADMINISTRATION OF ACQUIRED LAND.—On ac-  
23          quisition of land or an interest in land for the Center  
24          under subsection (a), the acquired land or interest in land

1 shall be administered by the Secretary for the purpose de-  
2 scribed in subsection (a).

3 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4       There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-  
5 retary such sums as are necessary to carry out this Act.
